Ephesians 2:13-19 New International Version (NIV)

¹³ But now in Christ Jesus you who once were far away have been brought near by the blood of Christ.

¹⁴ For he himself is our peace, who has made the two groups one and has destroyed the barrier, the dividing wall of hostility, ¹⁵ by setting aside in his flesh the law with its commands and regulations. Definition

Worldly sense

Peace is a concept of societal friendship and harmony in the absence of hostility and violence. In a social sense, peace is commonly used to mean a lack of conflict (such as war) and freedom from fear of violence between individuals or groups.

1 : a state of tranquility or quiet: such as a: freedom from civil disturbance ,**Peace** and order were finally restored in the town. b : a state

of security or order within a community provided for by law or custom a breach of the **peace**. It can mean one that is enforced on people or done voluntarily.

Godly sense

This is finding the peace that the ultimate peacemaker wants to bring to each of us. It is a peace that can be present even in the middle of trouble. This is the one we want to focus on today.

In **Matt 6:9-13**, we read in the Lord's Prayer that it is God's desire that His will would be done on earth as it is in Heaven. Peace is certainly reigning in Heaven. God's will is, for man to be at peace with Him. Then peace with each other. Inner peace must happen before outer peace can last. Real peace starts and ends with God. Even the little taste of worldly peace that the world gets, has God's flavouring it too because people have to want to lay down weapons to see any form of peace happen-that would indicate people caring for others. This means they have been influenced by God.

The war that needs peace

There is a war going on all the time in the lives of people. It is the flesh vs the Spirit of God. Ever since man sinned and brought judgement on himself from the error of his way rejecting God, there has been a war for his soul with the Lord wanting to redeem him back to Himself and the Devil not wanting to let go of the power over man's destiny which to the Devil now is destruction.

Our question today is?

Will you keep fighting God’s drawing you to Himself? God wants to make peace with us and He is the only one who can bring it to us.

Peace with God means surrender

When we accepted Jesus as our Saviour, we surrendered to Jesus initially as our Saviour. As we walk with Christ and have our lives transformed day to day (sanctification), our will becomes more and more surrendered to Him. Surrender is a daily matter that needs to be continually initiated. Surrender means we don’t allow our heart to determine the standard of Christian life we should have. We openly desire the walk Christ wants for us and follow that. Our will must surrender to the Lordship of Christ for us

to gain perfect peace. He is King and Lord. As Christians, there should never be a question of whether we will honour Jesus' desires or not. It should be automatic. When we surrender to Jesus, we will have peace. If not, then we won't.

Who is stronger, you or Him? Who is more powerful? Who is wiser? Who is more loving? Who is more giving? Who is perfect? Who has more? Who can heal? Who can cleanse from sin? I think God wins this argument every time.

Peace is everywhere in heaven where God dwells. He wants us to have it here on this earth too. He wants to make a real show of how bad the devil is and reveal to us all how good He is. The comparison needs to be seen.

How will you know if you have surrendered and are in a position to receive this peace?

Romans 8:5

Those who live according to the flesh have their minds set on what the flesh desires; but those who live in accordance with the Spirit have their minds set on what the Spirit desires.

If your life has been given over to Jesus and you have purposed now in your heart to serve Him, then you are in that position to receive it. It is a powerful place to be. It is a place where we just simply declare from our heart, Father I want to follow you in everything, what would you have me do.
